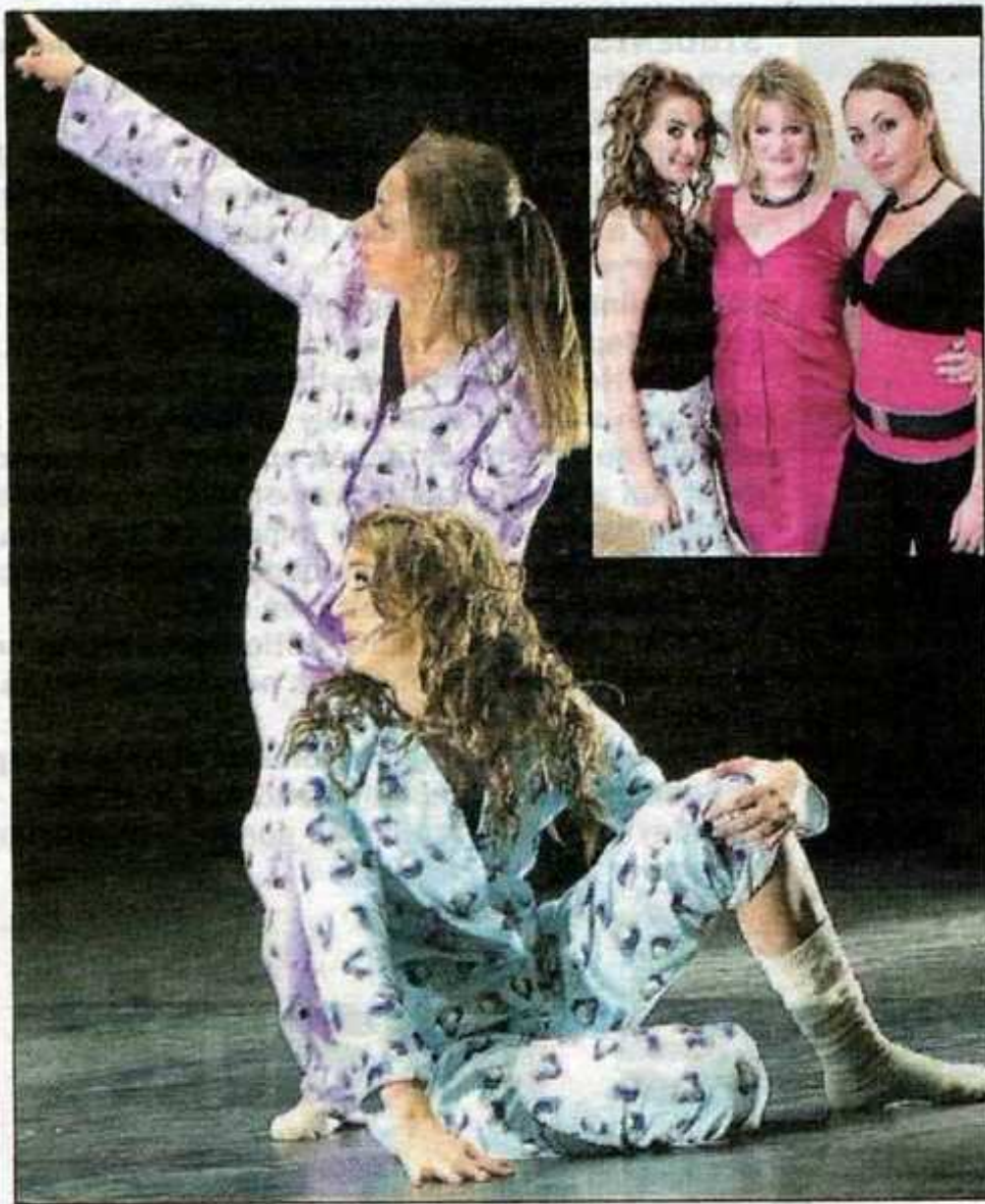


DANCING FOR LUKE



TWO sisters have created a moving tribute to the brother they never knew.

Luke Aston was killed in a blaze in Brookfield Mansions in May 1985. Although that was before they were born, dancing sisters Zoe-Ann, 20, and Holly, 15, always felt his loss within the family and decided to put on a moving performance in his memory on Saturday.

The pair danced before crowds at The Arts Depot in

North Finchley in a fundraising night for GroOops, a young person's counselling charity set up by the girls' mother Pennie Aston.

She said: "The dance, entitled Acceptance, expressed their feelings about never knowing Luke. As I watched the performance, it broke my heart."
